

NOTIFICATION OF RELIGIOUS OBSERVATIONS

The School of Pharmacy, University of California, San Francisco, recognizes that a day of religious observance may occasionally fall on a day upon which a class or an examination has been scheduled. Any student who will be in violation of his or her religious creed by participating in activities other than religious expression on such a day, should provide the Office of Student & Curricular Affairs with a list of such dates in the spaces provided below.

The periods involved for the 2009 – 2010 academic year are as follows:

Fall Quarter: September 24 – December 4, 2009
Winter Quarter: January 4 – March 12, 2010
Spring Quarter: March 29 – June 4, 2010

Should a conflict of dates occur that involves an examination, you may be asked to take the examination in question on a mutually arranged date prior to the scheduled examination date (normal practice is the day before the exam). Please complete the form below if you would like to request dates of religious observation.

All notification of such observances must be received by the OSACA no later than the first day of each quarter.

In the case of unresolved conflicts, students may appeal to the Dean of the School of Pharmacy.
